Announces New Course Offering:

Cal OSHA 10-Hour Construction Safety Training

Course Description

The JPIA is introducing another great benefit to our members beginning in 2011. We now offer the opportunity to obtain the **CalOSHA 10 Hour Construction Safety Card**. Several of JPIA's Risk Consultants have completed the required training to offer this to members. This course provides certification as developed by the OSHA Outreach Program, and has been tailored to water and wastewater operations by JPIA. Those attending should be experienced lead workers, foremen, job supervisors, construction inspectors or project managers. Training is based on Cal/OSHA construction safety standards. Once the two day training is completed, attendees will be issued a Department of Labor OSHA completion card.

Topics to be covered in the class include:

- Introduction to OSHA/CalOSHA
- Knowing your IIPP
- CalOSHA Focus Four: fall protection, electrical, lockout/tagout, struck-by
- Personal protective equipment
- Tools and equipment
- Hazard communication
- Confined space
- Traffic control
- Ergonomics
- Heat stress

All topics will be covered in the two days, and attendance in all sessions, both days is required. Although this is not an additional Professional Development Program (PDP) Specialty, students can request that the two day course be applied as five electives towards their PDP certification.

Not many organizations have instructors certified to offer this training, so we are very excited to make it available as another benefit of JPIA membership. To obtain this training elsewhere, fees can run from \$175 to almost \$300. This is another way the JPIA strives to help members stay safe, compliant and productive on the job.
