

SPLASH ALERT!



As of **April 1, 2015**, XL Group will replace Liberty International Underwriters as ACWA/JPIA's excess property insurer. The loss control engineering services provided by Arise and Global Risk Consultants (GRC) will now be provided through XL Group. Services will include:

- ◆ Jurisdictional inspections of air compressor and propane tanks
- ◆ Assistance inspecting hydropneumatic tanks
- ◆ Risk assessments of hydroelectric generation systems, electrical substations, and transformers
- ◆ Loss prevention analysis of electrical systems through infrared spectrometry
- ◆ Property assessments to include fire sprinkler system inspections, fire system impairment reporting, construction inspections, and construction management evaluations

Members should experience no change in scheduling of jurisdictional inspections. XL Group has the pools' database indicating the air compressor and propane tanks that are due for inspection in 2015. For inspection requirements of new equipment, members can contact their JPIA Risk Management Consultant to schedule an inspection. Inspection of hydropneumatic tanks can also be scheduled through a members' Risk Management Consultant. The ACWA/JPIA management staff will coordinate scheduling engineering assessments.

XL Group will use the same contacts to schedule visits and assessment support. JPIA Risk Management Consultants will accompany XL Group consultants during their initial visits, whenever possible.

With the change to using XL Group, the inspection report processes may take 30 — 60 days to put in place. XL Group provides these services nationwide. Their professionalism and experience should help make the transition as seamless as possible.
