WELCOME/INTRODUCTIONS

Chairman Gladbach welcomed everyone in attendance and introduced the Committee members, staff in attendance, and guests.

CALL TO ORDER AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF QUORUM

Chairman Gladbach called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. He announced there was a quorum.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/EVACUATION PROCEDURES

Chairman Gladbach led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mr. Sells gave the evacuation procedure instructions.

ANNOUNCEMENT RECORDING OF MEETING

Chairman Gladbach announced that the meeting would be recorded to assist in preparation of minutes. Recordings are only kept 30 days following the meeting, as mandated by the California Brown Act.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Chairman Gladbach noted that, as the agenda stated, members of the public would be allowed to address the Executive Committee on any agenda item prior to the Committee's decision on that item. Comments on any issues on the agenda, or not on the agenda, were also welcomed. No comments were brought forward.

ADMINISTRATION

Resolution (2018-2) Commending David Hodgin

Mr. Sells presented a resolution for approval to commend David T. Hodgin, of Scotts Valley Water District, for his eight and one half years of outstanding service to the Joint Powers Insurance Authority as a member of the Executive Committee, as Chairman of the Risk Management Committee, and Vice-chair of the Liability Committee.

Procedure for Responding to Claims Against the JPIA

Mr. Sells explained that the existing JPIA policies are silent as to an established procedure for responding to Government Claims received against the JPIA. The policy

would set forth an established procedure for responding to claims. Under the policy, the Chief Executive Officer would have the authority as delegated by the Executive Committee to respond to a claim and report the action to the Executive Committee at its next regular meeting.

CAJPA Accreditation Report

Mr. deBernardi explained that the JPIA went through the California Association of Joint Powers Authorities (CAJPA) accreditation process in 2018, where it was accredited with excellence for three years. The current accreditation report was presented for Executive Committee approval.

West Valley Water District

Ms. Thesing relayed that West Valley Water District (West Valley) contacted JPIA staff to advise that they have accepted the newly built hydroelectric generation facility at the Roemer Water Treatment Plant. Hydroelectric generation facility is a new exposure to West Valley and the unit was accepted into District's system on or about September 12, 2018, and thus, requires Executive Committee approval.

The hydroelectric generation unit has a total capacity of 522.2 kW including two Turbine Generators Systems: a 10TR Turbine Generator Unit 330kW and a 6TR Turbine Generator Unit 130kW. The power generated will power the Roemer Water Treatment Plant.

M/S/C (McDonald/Drake) (Cuquet-Yes; Drake-Yes; Gladbach-Yes; Hodgin-Yes; Knutson-Yes; LaMar-Yes; McDonald-Yes; Rupp-Yes; Tiegs-Yes): That the Executive Committee approve the hydroelectric power operations for West Valley Water District for Liability coverage, effective November 26, 2018.

Captive Insurance Company

Mr. Sells explained that the JPIA has been investigating the creation of a captive insurance company to reinsure select risks of various JPIA programs. The captive will benefit all programs by providing an efficient and diverse risk transfer mechanism. The diversity created by co-mingling risks provides greater stability. Assets held by the captive will be invested based upon the regulations of the domicile where the captive is

located. The JPIA has explored several domiciles and proposes developing a single-parent captive in the State of Utah.

There were many questions from the audience and much discussion on the subject. The Executive Committee expressed a desire to proceed on the formation of the captive and to recommend approval of the resolution at the Board meeting.

M/S/C (Hodgin/McDonald) (Cuquet-Yes; Drake-Yes; Gladbach-Yes; Hodgin-Yes; Knutson-Yes; LaMar-Yes; McDonald-Yes; Rupp-Yes; Tiegs-Yes): That the Executive Committee recommends approval of the resolution for the formation of the captive insurance company to be known as Joint Powers Captive Insurance by the Board of Directors.

Employee Benefits Renewal Update

Ms. Smith conveyed that all Employee Benefits Programs renewed for 2019 with no aggregate increase, with the exception of a 2.64% increase in Kaiser rates. Open Enrollment for 2019 was conducted from October 1, 2018 through November 9, 2018. MedImpact Pharmacy Benefit Manager implementation began July 13, 2018. Wellness Grants in the amount of \$77,958 have been distributed to 62 JPIA member agencies.

Staffing Update

Ms. Slaven presented an update on staffing at the JPIA. Four new hires were added to the JPIA staff this year and an additional two will be coming onboard at the beginning of 2019.

Website Update

Tara Bravo of CV Strategies demonstrated the newly updated JPIA website that is expected to launch relatively soon.

Significant Claims Report

Pursuant to Government Code 54956.95, Mr. Sells reported on claims that had been previously presented for authority:

- Felactu, et al vs. Mid-Peninsula Water District Water main failure. Claim settled for \$363,767.
- Dyson/Chriss, et al vs. Valley Center Municipal Water District Water main break. Claim settled for \$339,487.

Mr. Sells and staff updated the Committee on relevant current issues. Those discussed were:
