

This list is intended to be used as guidance regarding risk, safety, and health training requirements and recommendations for JPIA member water agency employees. *It is not an exhaustive list*, but instead pertains to the training available from JPIA to assist in awareness, meeting statutory training requirements, and also preventative best practice recommendations to reduce claims and risk.

Per CA Dept. of Industrial Relations, Code of Regulations Title 8, Section 3203(7), training and instruction should be provided:

- (A) When the program is first established;
- (B) To all new employees;
- (C) To all employees given new job assignments for which training has not be previously received;
- (D) Whenever new substances, processes, procedures, or equipment are introduced to the workplace and represent a new hazard;
- (E) Whenever the employer is made aware of a new or previously unrecognized hazard; and,
- (F) For supervisors to familiarize themselves with the safety and health hazards to which employees under their immediate direction and control may be exposed.

It is recommended that agencies review the State of CA Department of Industrial Relations Cal/OSHA Safety & Health Training and Instruction Requirements here and pursue other related local, state or federal agencies for further guidance.
