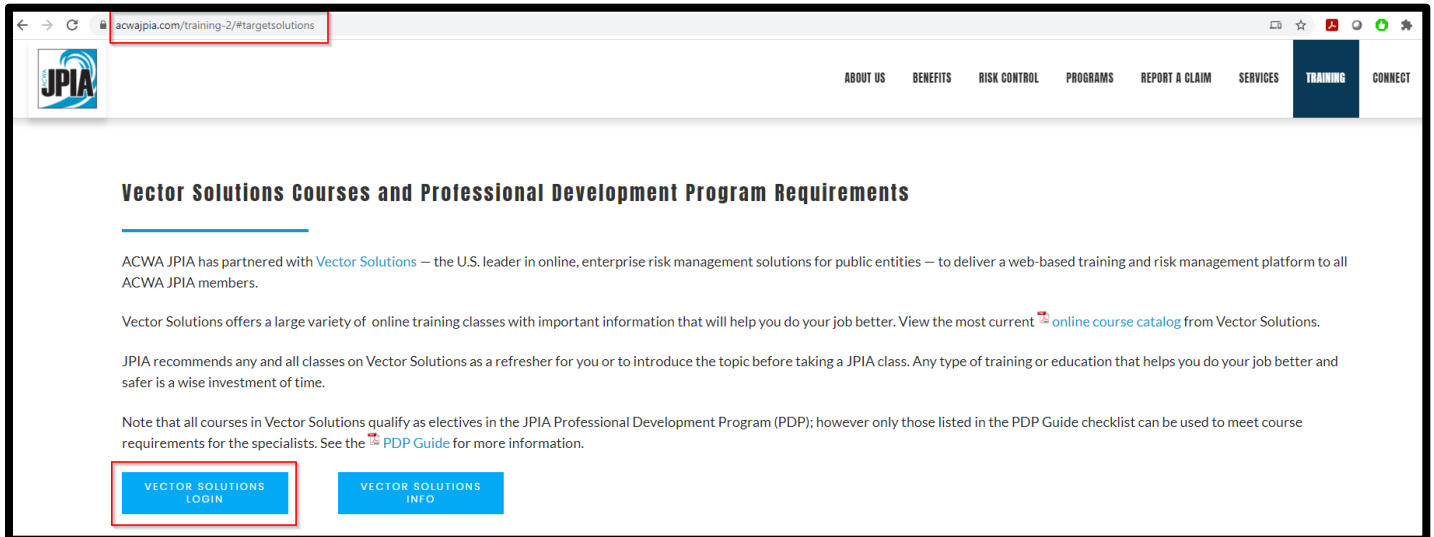

1. From the [ACWA JPIA Training site](http://acwajpia.com/training-2/#targetsolutions), select the Vector Solutions Login button.

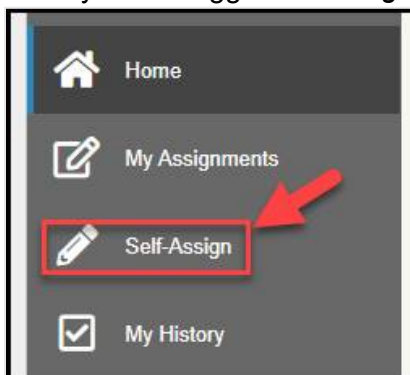

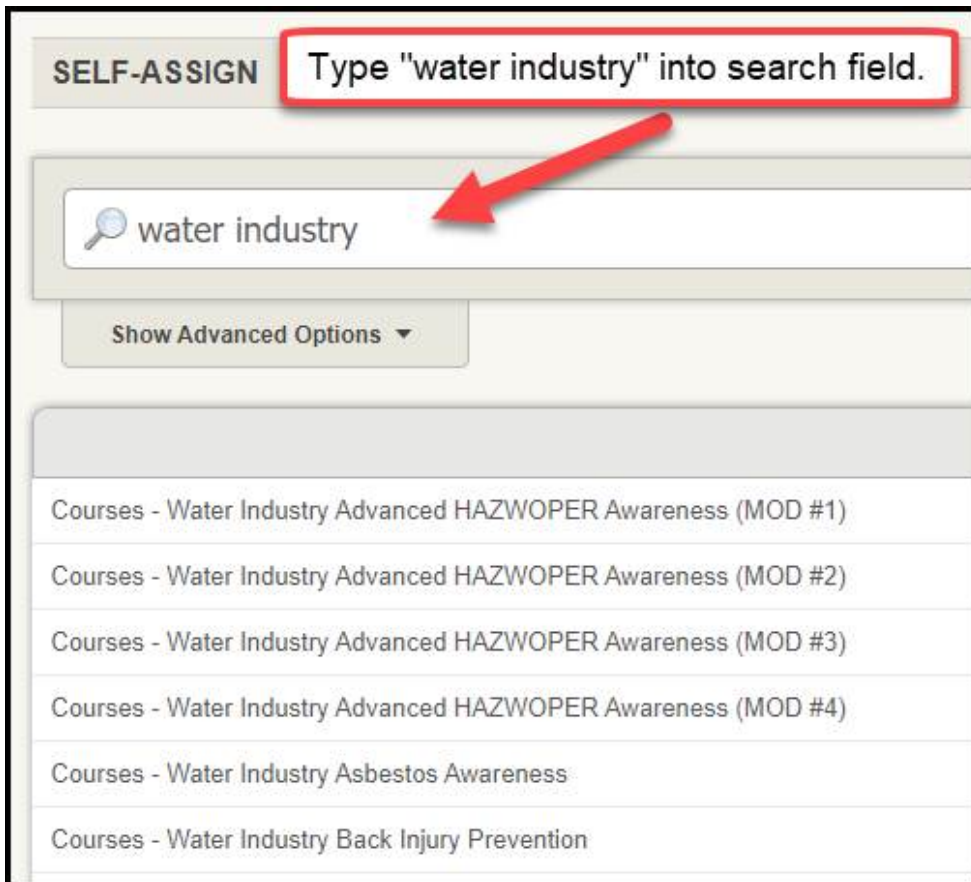


How to self-assign courses:

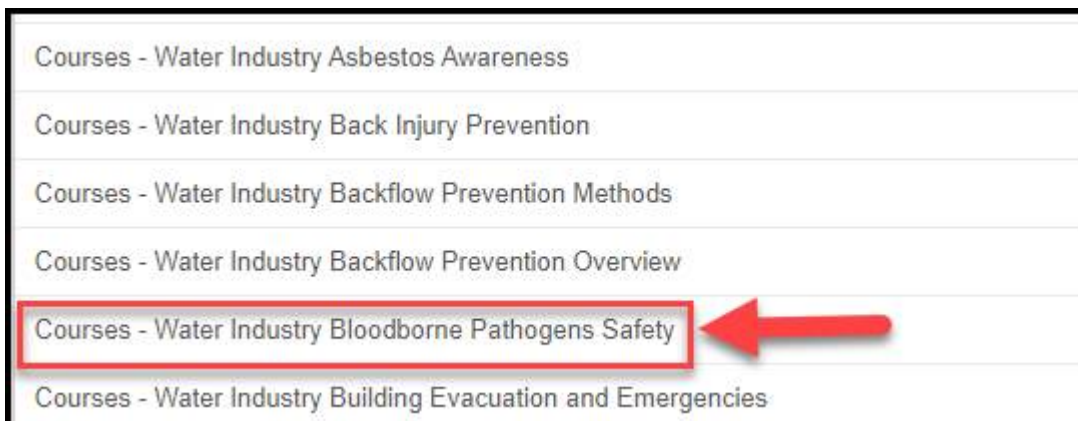
1. Once you are logged into *Target Solutions* click on the "Self-Assign" icon.

WATER INDUSTRY BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS SAFETY

Overview Blood and other potentially infectious materials pose a serious threat to employees who are exposed to these materials. Injuries from contaminated needles and other sharps have been associated with an increased risk of disease from more than 20 infectious agents. The primary agents of concern in current occupational settings are the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), hepatitis B virus (HBV), and hepatitis C virus (HCV). This course explains the requirements for complying with this standard as well as provides practical information on the various diseases and protection strategies associated with bloodborne pathogens. The course incorporates the 2001 OSHA revisions to the standard that were made in compliance with the Needlestick Safety and Prevention Act. This training course has 20 learning modules with a ten-question exam.

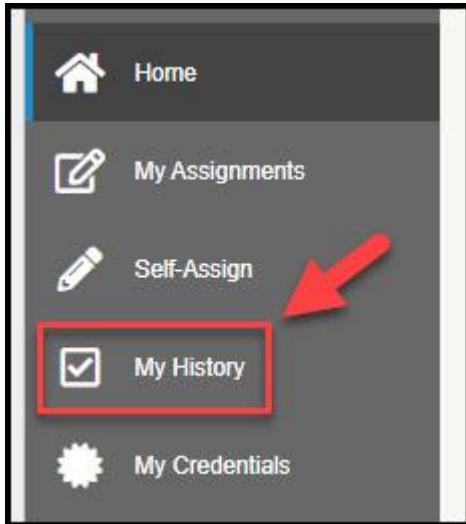

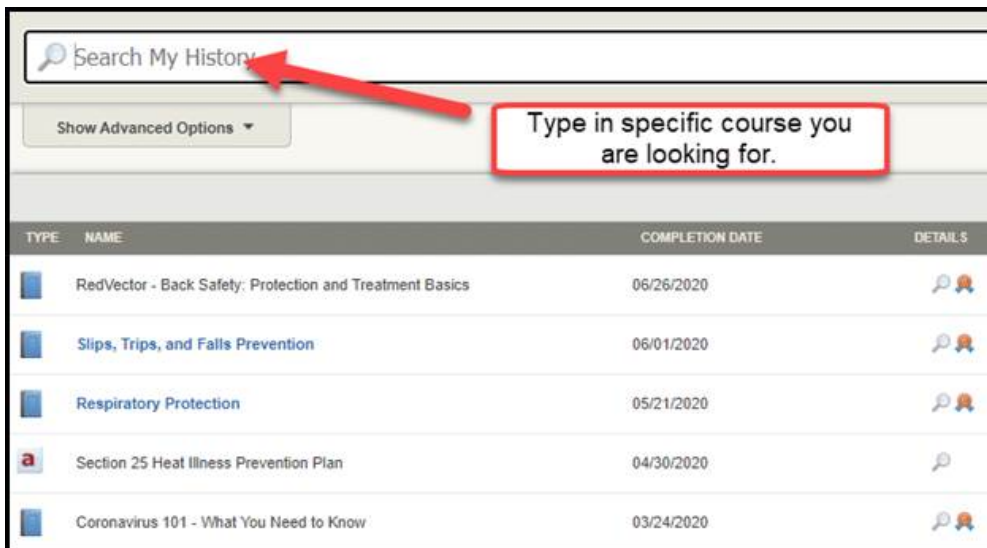
