## Ladder Inspection Checklist

## **Step Ladders**



Open Cracks, cracks, Open Gouges, gouges Fractures Surface Cracks Chips Scratches & scuffs Weathers, blooming, degradation Foreign materials: Paraffin, grease, mud

#### <u>Hardware</u>

Rust - Pins, hooks, locks, etc.
Looseness
Broken Hardware
Deformed, cracked, or gouged
Missing

#### <u>Rungs</u>

Wear & rung connection
Bends, deformities, cracks
Deep scores or damage

#### Locks & Pulleys

Locks Properly engaging
Binding, excessive play
Sharp burrs, edges, nicks
Rotation of keeper
Lubrication

#### <u>Ropes</u>

Cuts, fraying, wearBurns, mildew, rot

#### Safety Shoe

- Cracks or damage to extrusions
- □ Worn or dirt filled treads
- □ Wear of no more that 1/16" of pads

### <u>Step Ladders</u>

Spreaders-loose or missing rivets

- Cracks in side rails
- Foot pads
